Subject: A Level Results Day Arrangements, Certificate Collection and Special Consideration Information

Congratulations to your child on reaching the end of their A Level examinations.

We hope you are all enjoying a well-deserved break. As we approach Results Day, we would like to share some important information regarding the collection of examination results, post-results services, examination certificates, and updates on special consideration applications.

A Level Results Day – Thursday 13th August 2026

We look forward to welcoming students to collect their A Level and BTEC results on **Thursday 13th August 2026**. Results will be available for collection **from 8.00 am until 10:30 am**.

Students should enter the school via the Tetherdown Road Reception and collect their results from South Wing Hall. Sixth Form staff will be available throughout the morning to celebrate students' achievements and provide support, guidance and advice on next steps, including university places, Clearing and post-results services where appropriate.

If your child cannot attend in person or If your child is unable to collect their results themselves, they may:

- Authorise a representative to collect their results by providing a signed letter of permission. The representative must bring both the signed letter and their own valid photo ID.
- Provide the school with a self-addressed, first-class large stamped envelope by the end of the school day on **Friday 17th July 2026**, or leave it with the school security guard at the Tetherdown entrance on the designated collection dates before Results Day. Their results will then be posted on Results Day.

Results will also be available via the **Student's SIMS App** from **12:30pm**.

Please note that examination results cannot be released by email under any circumstances.

On Results Day

Students should:

- Bring a form of photo ID (a school lanyard with photo ID is perfectly acceptable).

- Enter via Tetherdown Reception.
- Collect their results from the South Wing Hall.

If your child is not planning to take up a university place through UCAS (for example, if they are going abroad, starting an apprenticeship, entering employment or taking a gap year), we would be grateful if they, or you on their behalf, could let Ms Richard or Ms Montague know as soon as possible.

Once students have collected their results and spoken to staff if required, they may leave the school site via the Tetherdown entrance.

Post-Results Services

Should your child wish to request a review of marking or access scripts following the publication of results, members of staff will be available on Results Day to explain the available services, deadlines and procedures.

Celebration Day and Certificate Collection – 17 December 2026

Our Celebration Day and Certificate Collection will take place on **17 December 2026** from 3.30pm until 4.30pm in T19.

Students who are unable to attend may collect their examination certificates from the South Wing Reception from **6 January 2027**, between 9.00am and 4.00pm.

Please note:

- Examination certificates must be collected in person and signed for.
- Students must bring valid photo ID.
- If someone else is collecting certificates on a student's behalf, they must bring written authorisation from the student together with their own valid photographic ID.
- Please encourage your child to keep their examination certificates in a safe place. Replacement certificates can be expensive to obtain and may take several weeks to arrive from the awarding bodies.

Special Consideration

For students who experienced significant circumstances during their examinations, such as illness, bereavement or other exceptional situations, the school has submitted Special Consideration applications to the relevant examination boards in accordance with JCQ regulations.

Please note that the decision to award Special Consideration rests solely with the examination boards. While successful applications may result in a small adjustment to marks, they do not guarantee a change in grade or overall outcome.
