Green Record Card

This is an A5 card on which your child can write down the times and dates of half termly lessons. It will be signed by the instrumental/ vocal teacher at the end of every lesson to confirm attendance. Record cards are available from the music noticeboard and the music office.

Yellow Pupil Progress Book

Your child will be given a Pupil Progress Book when they start learning. The teacher will make notes each lesson to support and extend learning, and complete termly assessments. This is a parent/ teacher contact book in which you may write.
