


fortismere Behaviour for Learning (BfL)


Parent / Carers will also be expected to come in for a meeting if you are placed in Isolation




- 1. There will be no integration with school.
- 2. Students will arrive at school at **9.00** and be collected by Mr. Johnson at the main gate in South Wing, they will not be allowed into school prior to this time
- 3. Isolation will finish at **3.30** and students will be taken to the gate unless they have a C3.
- All students to bring a packed lunch (if you have free school meals you will be given a packed lunch). You will not be allowed to go to the canteen or order from the canteen.
- All students will be expected to work and make progress

Clothing can be a powerful means of expression. We are proud of our students and respect their individuality. However, some clothing is inappropriate for school. So, absolutely no...




No see-through clothing or strapless tops. Minimum length of shorts /skirts to be fingertip length No ripped or torn garments. Positively no...


