# Minutes of the Parent Forum 7 December 2016 at 7.00pm

Please note that the discussions brought up (below) will be passed on to the Senior Leadership Team and Governors, which is why there is no immediate detail or response.

## **Discussion of Mobile Phone Policy**

Mrs. Glass discussed the rationale behind the introduction of the policy, primarily safeguarding issues (bullying, sharing inappropriate material, using phones to invite outsiders onsite) and the impact on social interaction of students. The policy has been amended so children can use phones to and from school in response to parents. Since the policy was implemented, six percent of children have had them confiscated.

- Parents/carers were mainly happy with the policy, saying that social interaction has improved.
- Parents/carers said they "were unhappy that children have to lie about having phones in their bags"; are not now able to be informed if their children have an unannounced sports match that day; pointed out that there was not a full consultation of parents beforehand, and wondered what is being done to help students with medical needs, such as life-threatening asthma, who may need to rely on a phone.
