

Do you prefer to learn in a practical or theoretical way?

Do you have a specific career in mind?

What kind of environment will you learn best in? **Practical: BTECs** might suit you. Especially if you have an idea about the career route you wish to pursue.

Theoretical: A Levels will suit you if you. Study your subjects in much more depth than GCSEs.

YES: Research to ensure you choose the right courses!

NO: That's fine: choose the subjects that you enjoy the most!

School 6th form: structure, support and academic expertise.

College: Less structure. Suitable for those who are extremely self motivated.

- Applications open on <u>Monday 11th Nov!</u>
- Speak to subject teachers about what subjects are like at A Level/ BTEC
- Analyse current performance honestly
- Check grades for entry criteria (see website)
- Attendance -maintain excellent standards
- Discuss choices with parents/carers
- Application deadline **25th January**
