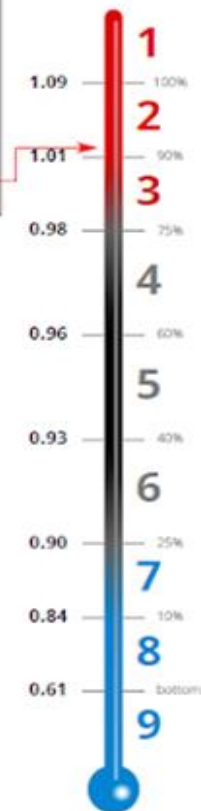
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Value Added Score

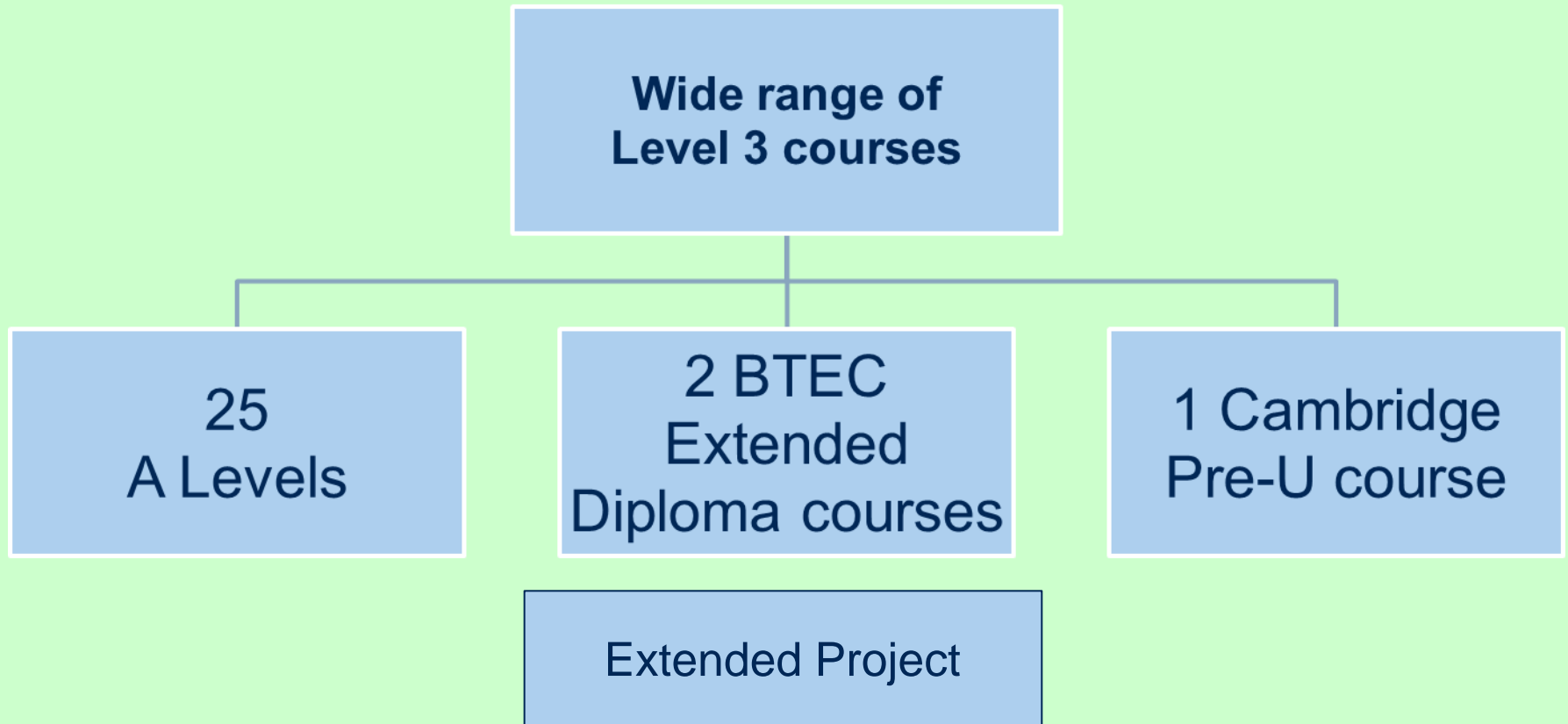
$$1 + \left(\frac{\text{Actual pts} - \text{Expected pts}}{\text{Entries} \times 100} \right)$$

- Application deadline 25th January
