



As a Secondary Teacher, you will work with students aged between 11 and 19. You'll usually specialise in one subject, although you might teach two or three subjects. Your work will include preparing and planning lessons, marking work, writing student reports, and attending meetings and parents' evenings.

Secondary Teachers often combine whole-class work with smaller group work based on practical projects.

As well as subject teaching, most secondary teachers are form tutors. This involves taking a register, giving out general information and giving guidance.

As a Secondary Teacher, you'll need:

- excellent communication skills
- planning and
